May 25 officially became National Tap Day by U.S. Congress in 1989.

The day was marked to recognize tap dance as an American Art Form. It also became a day to celebrate the enduring legacy of Bill "Bojangles" Robinson, (May 25, 1878 - November 25, 1949), and his outstanding contribution to the art of tap dancing on both stage and in film through the unification of diverse stylistic and racial elements.

Known as the grandfather of tap dance, you may recognize Bill "Bojangles" Robinson from his on screen time with Shirley Temple, or seen his infamous "Stair Dance." He danced for live audiences and films, became famous for his cheerful demeanour and "Everything's Copacetic" catchphrase, and remained in the public eye his whole life. Tap Day is now celebrated internationally, from Tokyo to New York City and throughout Canada, Europe and Asia. On Robinson's Birthday, we honour his legacy and generous spirit by bringing together our tap dance community.
